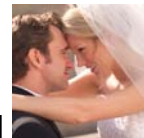
Newsletter: August 4th, 2011

Peter 1st came to Durango to go to Fort Lewis in 1974, it was here that Peter began climbing. After college he was Pine Needle Mountaineering's first employee. Peter also worked for Outward Bound and did several mountaineering expeditions into the Himalaya's. In 1983 Peter and a team of climbers including a TV documentary camera and crew went on an expedition to climb Mount Everest. Peter was the 14th American to Summit Everest and about the 130th person to ever reach its summit.
